The South Carolina Department of Consumer Affairs will offer **WEBINARS** during October, November, and December 2020. Each **WEBINAR** will last approximately ninety minutes (1.5 hours). **SC Code Ann. § 37-7-105(A)** Licensees must complete at least twelve hours of continuing professional education every two years. At least six of the twelve hours must be earned in a live instructional setting as opposed to a correspondence course or similar instructional method.\*
